The specialist glassworks is a member of the ANSA McAL Group of Companies, its founding fathers having laid the platform for a highly automated manufacturing facility, employing some of the best regional technical professionals.

QUAD GOB IN MEXICO

Quad gob productions are always challenging and require a highly experienced production team. The glass plant's team in Monterey, Mexico has made a good job. Heye contributed the machine belt including the new high-speed servo-pusher, [type 2158](#) with three servo axis.

The optimized motion profile results in a parallel pusher movement to the conveyor belt. Most of the movable parts are located below the machine conveyor level inside the pusher housing, protecting them from environmental influences such as heat and dirt.
